### **Surface preparation**

Concrete should be at least 28 days old and free of additives, curing agents, oils etc. Remove all loose and drummy areas to obtain a sound surface. Ensure that surfaces are free of dust, oil, and grease.

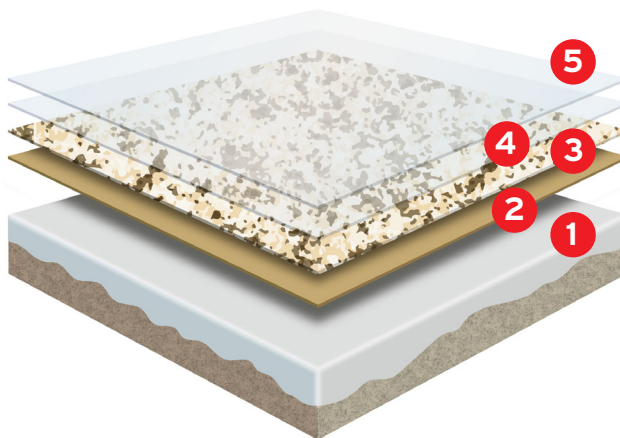
Prepare concrete by professional diamond grinding to exceed CSP 2 Standard.

Vacuum all dust and debris. Allow to dry if wet.

Always confirm preparation adequacy.

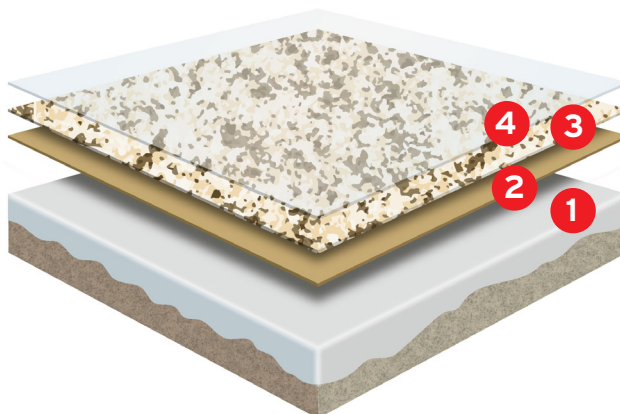
- ① Primer - EpiMax 237
- ② Base coat - EpiMax 350T pigmented
- ③ Broadcast selected Flakes
- ④ Seal coat - EpiMax 842/870/900/920
- ⑤ Topcoat - EpiMax 842/870/900/920

- ① Primer - EpiMax 237
- ② Base coat - EpiMax 842 pigmented
- ③ Broadcast selected Flakes
- ④ Seal/Topcoat in one - EpiMax 900HS
